***The Last Mutiny?  
Around the Horn to California on the Clan Buchanan***

**A 30-minute, illustrated slide lecture by Brian Dervin Dillon, Ph.D.**

The *Clan Buchanan* (above photo) was a *Windjammer*, built in Scotland for the California trade. Dillon's great-grandfather, William Muller, was aboard her, en route to San Francisco, when 12 of her 14 sailors were clapped in irons as mutineers. Muller served as a temporary sailor to keep the ship going, and helped smooth things over between her captain and crew, making completion of the voyage possible.
