Our Speaker: Nicholas Curry

His Subject: The Life of Daniel Murphy

The March Roundup will feature a presentation by Nick Curry, a long-time Los Angeles Corral member. Nick was not the author of the book on Daniel Murphy but he provided the extensive research required by Joseph Francis Ryan, the "author of *Ice & Oil*".

Daniel Murphy was a native of Pennsylvania. His family moved to Illinois and then to Kansas in the 1860s. As a young man Dan Murphy began working on a local railroad and after moving to Los Angeles, he secured employment as a brakeman on the Southern Pacific route to Yuma. Here he met Frank Monaghan and the two men developed the town of Needles. Murphy had many interests and eventually established an ice house to make it possible to transport the citrus crop from Southern California to eastern markets. Around 1900 he relocated to Los Angeles and invested in the Brea oil lands. His oil ventures included construction of a pipeline to the Standard Oil Refinery in El Segundo.

Murphy's wealth enabled him to reside with his wife in a luxurious home on West Adams Blvd. He began to donate much of his largess to the Roman Catholic Church, including the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. His philanthropy continued for the last three decades of his life and it continued by the Daniel Murphy Foundation.

Ryan's biography investigates the diverse aspects of the life of this relatively unknown benefactor. Attend the meeting and learn the full story of Dan Murphy.
