Our Speaker: Paul Clark

His Subject: The Rise of the Gasoline Cowboys

The May Westerners meeting will show how horse power took on new meaning about 1900 with motorized vehicles transforming transport and life throughout California and the world. Motorcycles participated in this movement away from the old "horse and buggy" leaving many in the dust whether figuratively or otherwise. The sport of recreational motorcycling attracted keen interest from the media, developed its own network of promotional literature and enjoyed events drawing large spectator crowds at times numbering over 10,000 spectators. California's climate welcomed outdoor sports, and motorcycling began early and remains a popular recreation to this day.

Our speaker, Paul Clark, as a graduate student at Cal State University, Fullerton, co-authored a 1978 report to the Federal government spanning the wide range of outdoor recreational history in the California Desert. After retirement in 2009 he picked up this subject again. Not the easiest topic to research, he traveled to Ohio in 2016 to the American Motorcycle Association's Museum and Library. In 2020 the Corral published *Brand Book 23* with his article focusing on outdoor motorcycle recreation in California from 1900 to World War II. He will go beyond his article with additional information, photographs, and even a yarn or two, "using a PowerPoint presentation."
