For over 30 years he has been involved with the judging of culinary contests for major food manufacturers such as Veg-all, Hormel Products, Hershey Foods, Knott's Berry Farm Foods, Ghirardelli Chocolate, and media including San Diego Union Tribune, ABC News Contests and many more. For 24 seasons, George was the Culinary Coordinator of the Los Angeles County Fair where his duties were to implement food contests daily with the coordination of the judges and competitors. The past 4 years found him working with major casting companies to help find talent for many of the new "reality" food shows on network television. His teaching/lecturing schedule regularly takes him around the world, teaching at over 200 schools, spas, wineries, and food festivals a year. He took to sea as a featured speaker and lecturer aboard Holland American Line ships visiting over 118 countries on every continent.

His wit and humor make his presentations fun and interesting.
