Our speaker is Tom Zoellner and his new memoir, Rim To River: Looking into the Heart of Arizona

Tom Zoellner is a fourth-generation Arizonan, he currently resides in LA where he teaches at Chapman University (he also teaches at Dartmouth College, in New Hampshire) and serves as the politics editor for the literary review magazine *Los Angeles Review of Books*.

Heart of Arizona (University of Arizona Press, March 2023) is about his journey hiking the 790-mile Arizona National Scenic Trail in 2019; the Arizona Trail traverses the entire north—south length of Arizona, from Mexico to Utah. It's a walking journey across the state with essays on wildfire, copper mining, border crossing, dirty politics, Native culture, violence, suburban monotony, shrinking water, local cuisine, literary culture, and the Grand Canyon. In essence, it's a deep narrative map of a complex state. It also grapples with what it means to call a place "home," be that home Arizona or any other state.

He won the National Book Critics Circle Award for his book *Island on Fire: The Revolt That Ended Slavery in the British Empire* (May 2020). His work has appeared in *The Atlantic*, *Harper's*, *The New Republic*, *American Scholar*, *Time*, *The Oxford American*, *The New York Times*, *The Boston Globe*, *The Los Angeles Times*, *The Washington Post*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *Foreign Policy* and many other places.
