**Our speaker will be Tracy Johnston, her presentation:  
The historic cookbook, *El cocinero Español*, (The Spanish Chef,  
or The Spanish Cook).**

Ms. Johnston will present on the historical cookbook that she translated, *El cocinero Español*, (The Spanish Chef, or The Spanish Cook) written by Encarnación Pinedo (1848 – 1902).

It was first published in 1898 in San Francisco, and was the first cookbook published by a Latina in the United States. It is also the first recording of *Californio* food—Mexican cuisine prepared by the Spanish-speaking peoples born in California. The cookbook offers a look into the kitchens of a long-ago culture that continues to exert influence today.

Robert “Bob” Shafer will present on the photo book *The Early History of Camp Cherry Valley*, a Boy Scout camp on Catalina Island. Bob will weave the beginnings of summer camps on Catalina Island against the backdrop of the island's development during the 1863 - 1864 mining boom, the Union Army's occupation during the Civil War and the 1915 - 1935 golden age of Hollywood's Catalina movie making. Camp Cherry Valley is owned and operated by the Greater Los Angeles Area Council of the Boy Scouts of America. It is located two coves north of Two Harbors at Cherry Cove, and is celebrating its 100th anniversary this year.
