Our Speaker is Carl Olson, Vice President of the Lions Automobile Museum

Carl Olson will speak on the famous Lions Drag Strip in Gardena. It was the brainchild of five local Lions Clubs and played a key role as the top drag strip west of the Mississippi from the late 1950's into the 1980's. It was the scene for technological advances adapted nationwide, while it boosted local street safety by keeping young racers off local streets.

Carl Olson was bornin in San Pedro in 1943 and was a 1961 graduate from San Pedro High School. After serving five years active-duty service in the U.S. Coast Guard, he owned and drove dragsters from 1965-1974. He was Vice President of the National Hot Rod Association from 1976-2001, after which he became Motorsport Manager of the SFI Foundation from 2001-2020. He is known as the "gold standard for defining a motorsports legend. This will be a look at cars and racing in the days when the activity took place on a track, not a city street.

Also at the February roundup Keepsake #58, Abe Hoffman's recollections of 50 years in the Corral will be distributed. Attend the meeting and be among the first to receive a hot off the press copy.
