



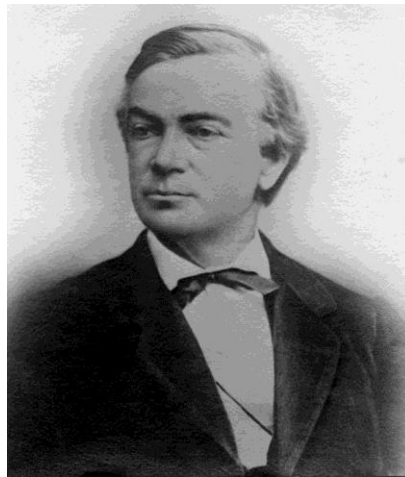

F. P. F. Temple, Forgotten City Maker of Los Angeles



Our own **Paul Spitzer** is a historian, archivist, and museum director. He grew up locally, attending Esperanza High School and California State University - Fullerton. He began his journey into history as a researcher for the Japanese American National Museum and has also consulted 13 years for the California State Parks Foundation regarding Latino history. He is an expert on the Lopez Adobe in San Fernando and presents to travelers on Road Scholars (Elderhostels) tours. He is a Board member of the Boyle Heights Historical Society and helped reorganize the Historical Society of Southern California. He has served as the Executive Director of the Workman Temple Museum for the last 35 years. By the way, the LA Corral held their Fandango at the Museum several years ago and Paul was our gracious host. He has authored three books: *Los Angeles Forgotten Tales* (2013), *Orange Countiana, Volume XII* (2016), and *The Workman and Temple Families of Southern California* (2007).
