Abe Hoffman will present a lecture: "Another Look at The Llano del Rio Colony."

For decades people driving along SR138 in the Antelope Valley have wondered about the two large stone chimneys by the side of the road. In recent years drivers have stopped at the site and shot videos of the ruins, putting their work on Youtube. Usually these brief videos say little about the history of these ruins. Abe Hoffman remedies the problem, telling two stories about the Llano del Rio Colony and how his research about it was for a graduate seminar at Cal State L.A. The paper became his first published article as he transitioned from a History major to History Teacher and Historian.

Abe Hoffman has been a member of the Los Angeles Corral of Westerners for more than fifty years and served as Sheriff in 1996. He has written articles for the Corral's Brand Books, Branding Iron, and Cowboy Poetry series, as well as Keepsakes. His latest contribution to the Keepsake Series, "Schools Dazed," tells of his career as a teacher in Los Angeles public schools and community colleges, and with any luck, will be ready for distribution at the Corral meeting.
