***Legends of the West: The True Story of the Lost Love Loot, and,
A legendary Phantom of the Southwest, the Ghost Ship of the Desert!***

Matthew Smathers will present an intriguing talk with a mix of both legend and mystery. ■

The Lost Love Loot of Simi Valley 2017: There is mysterious loot from which gold pieces were thought to be found. The possible site will be revealed in this talk. Did a lovesick cowboy try to win over his love's affection by robbing a stagecoach then burying it? Does this legendary local treasure still exist? Or was it only a tall tale from the golden age of western lore? What does it have to do with an infamous fated 'bar room encounter'?

And what of the Phantom Galleon? or the "Ghost Ship of the desert"? It is a noted spectral Spanish galleon or treasure ship often sighted near the Salton Sea in the Southern California Colorado desert. It is said to sail from dune to dune with a belly full of treasure... lost over a hundred miles from the nearest sea. Is there any proof of this phantom? Is it even remotely possible that such a ship even exists?

Perhaps these are both mere legends... or are they? Come to the January RoundUp and listen to the facts and tales explained by Mathhew Smathers who has both explored and collected information through the years. Then you may decide.

Matthew is an historian and lecturer and a maritime historian and explorer of shipwrecks. He is the founder of "Storied Treasures", a Southern California based shipwreck and outdoor exploration group.
